New Vienna Concession Stand report

Sue presented a question from band parent Kelly Brown regarding band fees. She is requesting a report on amounts due and amounts fund-raised by members. Susan Thompson and Mr. Minge are coordinating that information and it should be available within the next week or so.

Mr. Minge's report: Band camp was a success, in spite of the lack of a band room due to the new carpet being installed. Discussion surrounded the purchase of a winter guard tarp. The cost of the tarp is yet to be determined, but donations from businesses can be solicited.

Sue will contact uniform parents to see if they are available tomorrow from 6-9 to help fit uniforms for brass and woodwind (28 members). Most members have already been fitted, however new members need to be fitted.

Chili Supper

Discussion continues on a pre-game supper on October 19 from 5:30 to 7:30 featuring small groups of band students playing pep music. Menu to include hot dogs, chili, chips, cookies and drinks.

Bingo

The group suggested bingo in January and possibly late March.
