Mr. Minge's report

The band trip to Gatlinburg was approved by a majority of parents. Trip costs are \$475 per person, including meals. Students will receive a payment schedule and trip itinerary from Horizons.

Mr. Minge plans to requisition for funds for a new field commander stand, along with a new podium, tympani, chairs and rolling racks and music.

Mr. Minge plans to ask for school backing on alternating between towns for Memorial Day parades. He was not able to get approval from either municipality yet.

Band boosters will be responsible for purchasing formal wear for performances if needed.

Mr. Minge will ask the school administration to support the band having a night off from an away game before a competition. This could save fuel costs which could then later be requested for needed items.

Band camp cookout is scheduled for Friday the 25<sup>th</sup> of July. Mr. Minge will arrange for the grill to be moved to the field. Band boosters provide hot dogs, plates, buns, napkins and condiments.

Next meeting scheduled for July 23 at 7 p.m, with a parent meeting immediately following.
