

Band Booster Minutes
April 3, 2006

Sam reported on a butter braid sale as the next fundraiser. Items are \$9 each. The boosters will receive \$4 from each sale. Orders are due back after Spring break.

Packets of information on the Disney trip were distributed. An informational meeting is scheduled for April 25, at 7:00 p.m. The first deposit is due in June. A total of 110 people can attend the trip. More information to follow.

Mr. Minge reported on the scrip program. He suggested we reduce the student contributions from \$75 to \$25, at which point students accounts will begin to accrue money at 50/50 rate in their individual accounts. Sue has advertised the event in the local papers, and will advertise on the radio this week.

Sue reported on the uniform drive mailing. It was suggested that band alumni be added to the mailing list. Sue will contact former band member, Genevieve Faehnle, to ask for help with this project. Sue will complete the mailing with the current list by the end of this week.

Sue reported on the GOBA event, scheduled for June 19. Flyers with more information and requests for drink donations will be attached to the spring band concert program on May 15.

Kathy suggested another chili supper be held before homecoming this year. Kathy will reserve the kitchen. Details to follow.

Jani suggested the boosters hold another car wash. Mr. Minge would like to expand on the idea and suggested we hold a car wash at Walmart for the guard, and a car wash at Liberty Savings for the band. His goal is to hold one car wash per month during the summer.

Mr. Minge has been approached by several band parents with questions about band cards. Discussion followed. Jani is willing to make the solicitation calls if the group would like to go ahead with the project. It was suggested that we make sure to offer the cards before September of this year, as that is when similar cards go on sale.
