August 14, 2006

Kathy asked about band fees and a treasurer's report. Fees and donations will be kept in a lockbox donated by Charles Ely. No treasurer's report was available.

Kathy asked about thank you notes being sent to donors to the uniform drive. Secretary asked for a report from the treasurer so notes can be mailed.

Mr. Minge report emailed to Kathy:

An alternate date for band photo is being requested. More details to follow.

Susan Thompson has all Disney trip information. We may be able to fit onto one bus.

Current uniforms need to be drycleaned. Kathy will research prices.

Meals for away games – will anything be organized? Need a volunteer to coordinate.

Cathy will ask Kim Starr to coordinate.

Carwash

Scheduled at Liberty Savings from 1-4 on September 9, 2006. Kids should bring a sack lunch, ride the bus to the park, eat, change, and walk back to Liberty Savings. Parents should pick up students at 4:00. Three or four adult volunteers are needed.

Bylaws

Sue asked what items are within the scope of the district revenue. Mr. Minge researched and came up with the following:

Guard instructor is paid via supplemental from board

Assistant directors are paid \$1000 each. School board provides \$500 total. Band

Boosters must make up the difference.

Drill writer fee is \$1,200 approximately. Currently expenses come from band boosters, however the boosters feel as though salaries should come from district funds which free up booster funds for contest entry fees, uniforms, trips, trailer renovations etc.

Kathy tabled the discussion until more research can be done.

Jani volunteered to measure the rest of the guard for uniforms, as they cannot be ordered until all measurements are complete.

Kathy reported that she plans to research the amount of revenue generated by ticket sales at football games. Band parents contribute to the revenue generated, but band does not benefit from the sales in any way.

Canopy for booster sales

No information from Mr. Minge. Kathy contacted Mr. Lynch. During their discussion she mentioned boosters selling items with the Astro logo only, no band information. He asked that we approach an Athletic booster office with the situation. Kathy will attend their meeting next

Monday. Discussion followed surrounding additional items to sell during games. Items included scarves, hats and gloves.

Jani asked for an updated phone list—many of the numbers on her list are incorrect. Cathy showed the group an information sheet sent home last year. Discussion followed. Boosters agreed to send home the notice again, Sue will collate the information and distribute to booster officers.

Kroger cards

Sue made a motion to purchase cards for all band members with \$1.00. Cards will be sent home to each band member with a letter explaining their use. Twenty cards will also be purchased with a \$5.00 balance to be sold at football games. Cathy seconded. Motion passed.
